

CHAPTER 5

POISON REGULATIONS

~~Section 1. Authority. These regulations are promulgated as authorized by the Act.~~

~~Section 2. Definitions.~~

~~(a) "Drug" means items intended for use in the diagnosis, cure, mitigation, treatment or prevention of disease when used either internally or externally. Any item listed in an official compendium (i.e. U.S.P. or N.F.) is presumed to be a drug.~~

~~(b) "Label" means a display of written, printed or pictorial matter bearing any of the following signals, words or symbols of "Poison", "Danger", "Warning", "Caution" or the "skull and crossbones" symbol, upon the immediate container of any drug, chemical or preparation. This same information shall appear on the outside container or wrapper, unless the information is easily legible through the outside container or wrapper.~~

~~(c) "Poison" means any substance having an inherent deleterious property, which when internally or externally applied to the body of man or animal is capable of causing damage to the tissues, destroying the action of vital functions of the body or causing death.~~

~~(d) "Wholesale" means any person or firm who normally supplies or distributes drugs, medicines or poisons, that he himself has not derived, produced, packaged or repackaged for sale.~~

~~Section 3. Poison Schedules and Labeling Requirements.~~

~~(a) "Poisons as scheduled and recognized by the Board shall remain in effect until revised by the Board.~~

~~(i) Schedule A—Includes only those items which may be dispensed pursuant to a valid prescription.~~

~~(ii) Schedule B—Includes those poisons purchased in the original package and must bear all information required.~~

~~(b) All Schedule B poisons offered for sale by a pharmacy shall comply with applicable labeling requirements of W.S. 33-24-138 and shall bear the word "poison" and the recognized antidote.~~

~~(c) A poison shall not be delivered until the purchaser is informed of its poisonous character.~~

~~(d) No poison shall be sold to a person under the age of nineteen (19) years, except upon the request of an adult known to the vendor. No poison shall be sold to a person of unsound mind or under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances.~~
