Chapter 8 CSA con't		Section 2: Changes description of required field names to transmit to PDMP, not later than 7 days after dispensing. Deletes paper transmission.
Chapter 8 CSA con't		Allows spreadsheet reports to regulatory boards, online process for reports, third party to request reports with patient's consent, electronic signatures for online requests by prescribers or pharmacists.

Chapter 2 (Spelling, numbering, format corrected throughout,	General Practice of Pharmacy Regulations	Section 4: Definitions of audit trail, authentication, electronic prescription, electronic transmission, paper prescription, pharmaceutical care, pharmacy intern, readily retrievable,
Chapter 2 con't		Section 10 allows pharmacy interns to transfer prescriptions, electronic transfers, pharmacist to determine if electronic prescription was previously transferred, maintains transfer record for 2 years
Chapter 2 con't		Section 19 allows digital or electronic signature as "recognizable" for non-controlled
Chapter 2 con't		Section 28 changes drug therapy management to medication therapy management
Chapter 2 con't		Section 29 allows electronic or digital signatures, electronic prescription rules, prescribing/dispensing systems must be certified by a third party, 21 CFR § 1311
Chapter 2 con't		Section 30 adds statements for new ownership of retail pharmacies
