

2011 Summary of Legislative Changes to the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act

35-7-1014	Schedule I	Adds synthetic cannabinoids (“spice” drugs), Salvinorum A, MDPV (“bath salts”)and updates listings in C-I to the federal law
35-7-1016	Schedule II	Adds oripavine, tapentadol, lisdexamfetamine
35-7-1018	Schedule III	Updates to federal law listings, adds boldione
35-7-1020	Schedule IV	Updates to federal law listings, adds fospropofol, carisoprodol, tramadol
35-7-1022	Schedule V	Updates lacosamide, pregabalin
35-7-1024	Controlled Substance Registration	Practitioners now have a two year registration, late fee July 1
35-7-1030	Prescriptions for Controlled Substances	Adds “or electronic”
35-7-1031	Marihuana prescriptions	Prohibited except dronabinol
35-7-1059	Methamphetamine Precursors	Updates to federal law for 3.6 gm purchase in one calendar day, 9 gm in 30 days, 2 pkg limit per sale, logbook requirements
35-7-1060	Prescription Drug Monitoring Program	Allows a report if the patient has signed a specific consent
