Chapter 1 WPA (spelling, numbering, format corrected throughout)	Practice and Procedure of the Board of Pharmacy	Updated procedures for complaints, investigations, and hearings
Chapter 3 WPA	Pharmacy Intern	Clarifies definitions and intern hours
Chapter 4 WPA	Code of Ethics	Clarifies and combines elements in the Code of Ethics
Chapter 6 WPA	Continuing Professional Education	Changes the title and clarifies the use of CPE Monitor from NABP and how audits will be conducted in the future.
Chapter 9 WPA	Counseling and DUR	Deletes duplicate, outdated, and extraneous language.
Chapter 12 WPA	Institutional Pharmacy	Clarifies and simplifies language, removes specific references for categories required, clarifies emergency outpatient medications, references FDA recommendations for destruction of transdermal controlled substance patches.
Chapter 13 WPA	Non-Sterile Compounding	Changes the title to Non-Sterile Compounding and updates to USP Chapter 795 by adding definitions and the Master Compounding Record elements
Chapter 15 WPA	Long Term Care Pharmacy Services	Clarifies roles of provider pharmacies and consultant pharmacists. Automated dispensing device requirements are listed.
Chapter 16 WPA	Immunizations	Based on new legislation HB0094 a pharmacist is now allowed to prescribe and administer vaccines to a healthy individual age 7 and older. Definitions of minor, private space, vaccine are listed. Influenza vaccine is allowed to be administered by a pharmacist to a minor. Consent is required for minors and the parent or legal guardian shall be present during administration.
Chapter 16 WPA	Immunizations	Requirements for the pharmacist to have training specific to pediatrics if they will administer vaccines to minors.
Chapter 16 WPA	Immunizations	Section 7 sets up the requirement that the patient will be seated with back support.
Chapter 16 WPA	Immunizations	The consent form will document that side effects and treatment of them have been discussed.
Chapter 16 WPA	Immunizations	Section 11 sets up requirements for records, storage, transport, and disposal of vaccines administered by a pharmacist off-site.
