Prescription Drug Abuse-buprenorphine: A notice from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention explained the increase in Buprenorphine being ingested by children in 2010 through 2011. This information was conducted through emergency room visits and hospitalizations.

Medicaid pregnancy project. November 1, 2011 Wyoming Medicaid along with the Drug Utilization Review Contractor began a new program targeting pregnant women taking narcotics. Women are identified through the Pregnant Woman's Program and then patient profiles are researched looking for narcotics and multiple prescribers. Education letters are sent to the OB provider and the narcotic prescribers along with the patient's medication profile. A statistical breakdown of the program is provided in the board packet.
