Update on renewals for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians: Renewals were sent out a little later than usual due to last minutes changes for GL Solutions. At this time we have twenty (20) successful renewals online.

DEA letter "Dear Practitioner" regarding wasting of controlled substances: The letter from the DEA was discussed and Bessie McGirr stated she would like to have the long term care rules updated in the future.

Immunization training at Iowa State: Charlie Smith made the motion to accept this immunization course. John McPherson seconded the motion which passed with a 5-0 vote.

Pneumonia vaccine: There was a discussion regarding our rules. Bessie McGirr made the motion to remove Polysaccharide from our rules. Jim Massengill seconded which passed with a 5-0 vote.

Legislation: Delegate accounts for WORx, daily reporting by pharmacies to the WORx Program by January 1, 2016: There was a discussion on working toward 24 hour reporting. Not all information being sent is getting to Atlantic Associates. Mary Walker will contact Atlantic Associates. Changes to Schedules to match federal law (2011 to

2014): Will be added to proposed changes to the Controlled Substance Act. Senator Bebout has agreed to be a sponsor. Donna Murray will assist with draft language.

Jim Massengill made the motion to adjourn at 7:35. John McPherson seconded the motion which passed with a 5-0 vote.

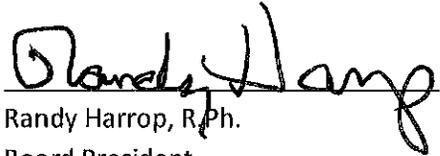
